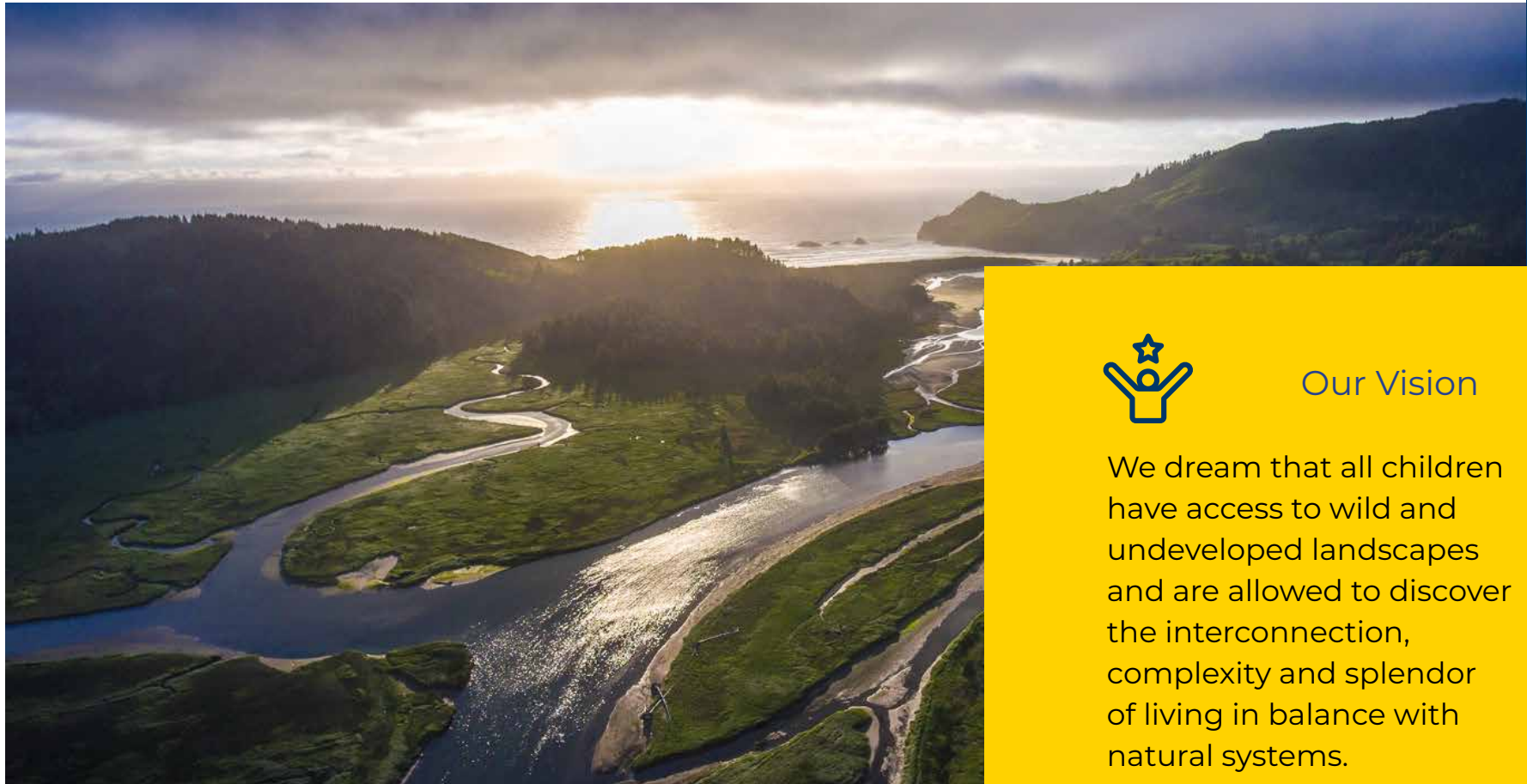

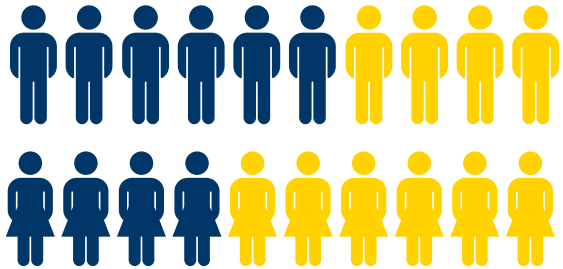

Federal and State of Oregon grant funding was available due to COVID-19 support, including funds provided through Westwind's partnership with Outdoor School.

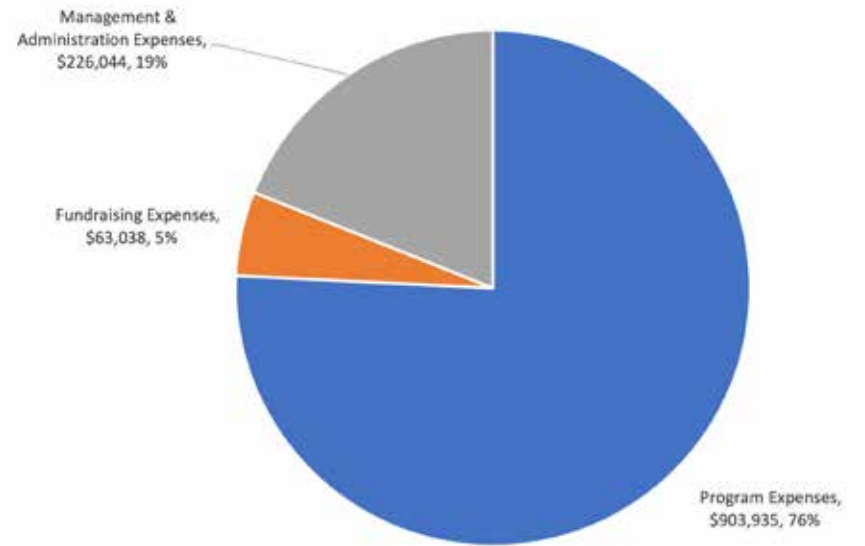

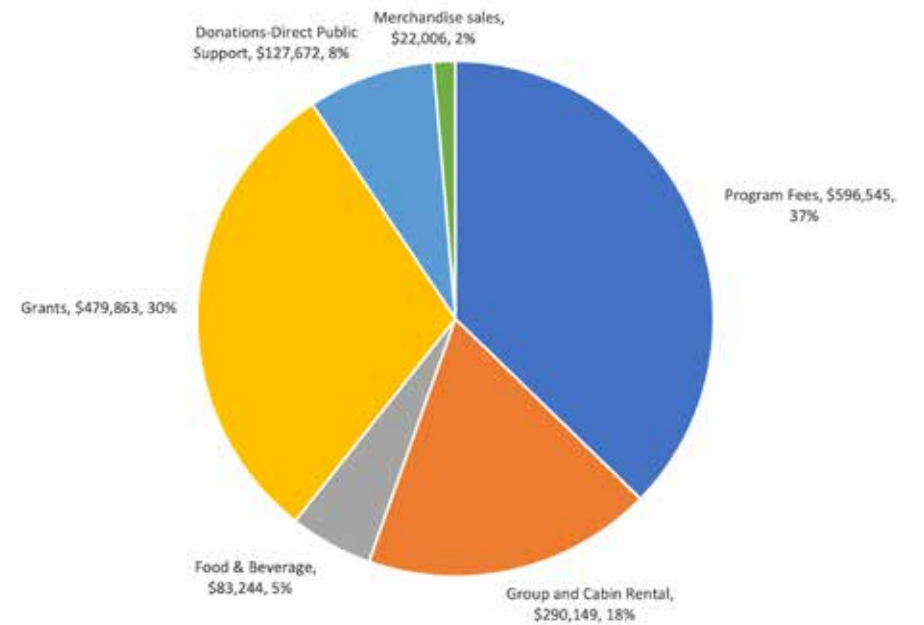
The Westwind community continued to offer generous support as Westwind dealt with the challenges presented by COVID-19 cancellations and closures.
