CASCADE HEAD SCENIC RESEARCH AREA
This marks the southern boundary of the 9,670 acre Cascade Head Scenic Research Area (CHSRA). From here CHSRA extends north and includes all of Westwind and Cascade Head Preserve. Protected by U.S. congress in 1974, the entire area (including the Cascade Head Experimental Forest) was designated a U.N. Biosphere Reserve in 1975.

SIUSLAW NATIONAL FOREST
Siuslaw National Forest land is managed by the Hebo Ranger District of the U.S. Forest Service, and is open to the general public on a day-use basis. Access to the Westwind property is limited to WSG program participants, volunteers and staff only.
